

Roseburg man wins \$4,000 scholarship

David Bartlett of Roseburg is the first of four winners of \$4,000 scholarships to be given away in March, which is Oregon College Savings Month.

Each week, one person who opens an Oregon College Savings Plan account authorized by Section 529 of the federal tax code can win \$4,000 in a drawing. The money must be placed in a state account, and it can be deducted from 2008 state income-tax returns due in 2009.

Bartlett was the first to attend college in his family. He set up the account for his 4-month-old granddaughter; four other grandchildren already have accounts. For details, go to www.oregoncollegesavings.com.
